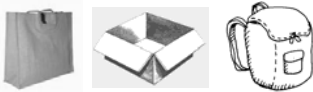
Security Risk Level

Car Evacuation Zone



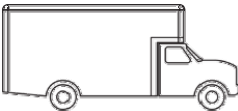
1,750 ft or 390 Meters

Advisory

Banks, grocers and discount stores across the country have been targeted by a caller who threatens to blow up shoppers and workers with a bomb if employees fail to wire money to an account overseas. The callers also have insinuated that they have hacked into store security cameras to monitor their hostages. There have been over a dozen threats from California to Virginia and Maine to Florida. Four threats occurred on Friday morning forcing the evacuations of stores in northeastern Ohio. The FBI is looking into whether the calls to the banks and stores were being placed from outside the country. The investigation continues.

Every business should have procedures in place that cover what to do in case of a bomb threat. Any threat should be taken seriously and businesses should be prepared to suspend regular work hours and procedures as necessary to ensure the safety of employees, customers and other innocent bystanders.

In the event you receive a threatening phone call it is important you stay calm and get as much information as you can without irritating the caller.

If you receive a threatening phone call:

1. Listen carefully & look at the caller I.D.
2. Write everything down (use attached template)
3. Listen for background noise.
4. Listen to the voices, tone or accent
5. Call 911



If you see a suspicious looking box, package, object, or container in or near your work area, it may be a bomb or explosive material. Don't be a hero—do the following:

If you see a suspicious package:

1. Stop — **DO NOT TOUCH IT**
2. Isolate/Evacuate the area
3. Call 911
4. Activate your emergency response plan

Two most common remote detonation devices are the cell phone and the remote garage door opener.
